Welcome to our 2024–2025 Season! We have exciting news and events planned for this year and we are so happy to share it with our community!



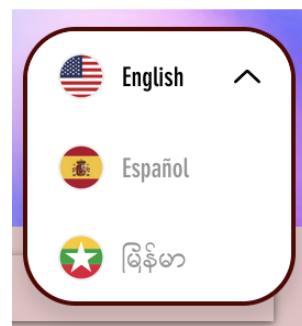
New LHS Theatre App Available Soon!

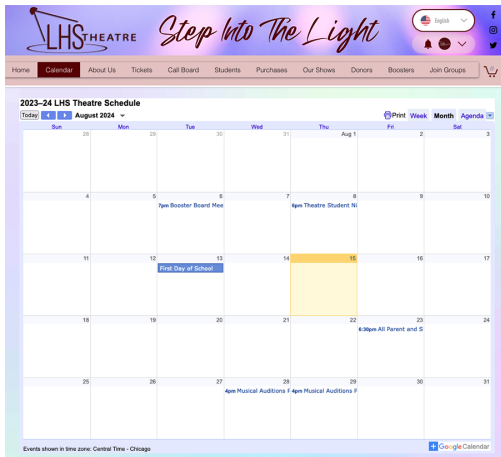
Our Full Season!
